WHAT IS TNT?

TNT is an acronym that stands for The Naked Truth about Drugs and Alcohol. This organization speaks "The Naked Truth" about the explosive issues of drug and alcohol abuse.

TNT is a voluntary non-profit organization made up of members from different walks of life. All of whom have been through the horror of being addicted, have come free and now live fulfilled lives.

We speak at schools, universities, prisons, youth groups, businesses, military camps, rehabilitation centers and at a number of other institutions. Our method is to tell our own stories and experiences. We find that this realistic approach is well received and understood by all. It is after all simply "The Naked Truth"!

We also provide information and support by offering a 24 hour Helpline, a website, information leaflets, posters and other services.

Established in 1996, TNT came into existence in response to a need expressed by a group of people who were concerned about the ever increasing chemical dependence* problem in South Africa.

TNT REPRESENTATIVES

The TNT representatives are those members that go out to speak at different institutions. They are a multi-cultural group of individuals who share their own experiences of addiction.

All the TNT representatives are volunteers and are not paid for their help. Some even take unpaid leave in order to go out on TNT campaigns.
