



FIFA 2010 WORLD CUP

The FIFA 2010 World Cup kicks off on 11 June 2010. There will be huge audiences at all the venues. It is a marvelous opportunity to reach out, in a small way, with Gospel tracts. A group in the USA, The Inner-city Church Planting Mission with Pastor Daniel Schutte, has kindly printed, free of charge, about 15 000 tracts for us to hand out during the soccer World Cup. A space has been left at the back of the tract, for you, your CFT branch or any other Christian organisation or church, to put a contact number, email or website. We advise you to work with the Provincial CFT committees to jointly obtain information about the exact times and places for tracts to be handed out. Do your best to stay on the right side of the law. FIFA and SAPS rules will be very strict, so make sure that you know the best strategic places to evangelize.

The wording of the tract reads as follows:

Welcome to the World Cup in South Africa!

You are here to support your country and team. It is your hope and desire that your country will be "World Champions" on July 11th! This is "The Ultimate Goal".

But let us tell you of even a more important "goal" that you should have. That is, the "goal" of being declared a righteous follower of the ONE TRUE GOD, and thus assured of an eternal home in heaven some day when you die!

It is written in GOD's Word the Bible that, "There is none righteous, no not one. For all have sinned and come short of the glory of GOD." (Romans 3:10,23)

You, me... we're all wretched sinners... not only bound for hell, but condemned to a worthless existence here on earth as well.

But it need not be that way!

CFT together with other Pro-lifers have participated in placard demonstrations in various towns and cities. We report on just 3 of the many Pro-life functions: Atteridgeville – Pretoria / Ballito / Paris.

SOUTH AFRICA - Since the promulgation of abortion on demand on 1 February 1997 there have been over 900 000 "lawful" elimination's of unborn babies.

GAUTENG: The CFT chairperson in **Gauteng**, Dieter Claassen, reported:
"Approximately 50 members of CFT and BCN (Biblical Christian Network) participated in a Life-Chain on the 30th January at a busy intersection in Atteridgeville. Pamphlets were distributed and placards displayed. In general we got a good response from the public. Some members of CFT reckoned it was one of the most successful Life-Chains we have had. About 5 members of the Metro police monitored proceedings. They were very friendly. One officer told me that the message was definitively seen and understood by the community.

For the first hour approximately 1800 people passed through the intersection, which is actually a low figure when one compares it to some of the intersections in Centurion and Randburg where we have held Life-Chains previously. However, in the second hour an almost endless stream of (mostly expensive) cars from a funeral procession passed by. Saturday is funeral day in Atteridgeville.

One black gentleman stopped his car and spoke to some CFT members. He pleaded with us to focus our attention on the poorer parts of Atteridgeville. He is a businessman and has offered his help in any future CFT ventures. He said that the biggest problem facing Atteridgeville is AIDS.

I was also contacted by Solidariteit Radio for an interview regarding the Life-Chain. We thank God that all went well."

KZN: With regards to the Life-Chain held in **Ballito**, a report was written in "The North Coast Courier" February 12, 2010:

"In the blistering heat of Sunday midday on February 7, a large crowd of caring and dedicated folk gathered to highlight the rights of unborn children.

Nina McNeil organized the protest on behalf of Christians for Truth.

Before setting off to stand silently on the side of the roads, a short meeting was held.

Lezette Meyer from Doctors for Life International told the crowd that they provide 11th hour counselling and support."

FRANCE: Paris Walk of Life - Sunday, 17 January 2010

"We thank the Lord for the Walk of Life in Paris on Sunday afternoon. CFT joined a march organized by Pro-Life movements. About 20 000 people participated in the 3km walk. Jan de Bruin, representative of CFT Netherlands, was invited to give a short speech and tracts with Ps139:15 printed on them were handed out.

24 young girls from CFT wore necklaces consisting of 24 artificial life-size embryos at 10 weeks of gestation. This signified the number of abortions that take place in France every day and 210 000 abortions are performed every year. Many journalists took photos of the girls.

The weather forecast predicted rain and bad weather and so we were thankful to have a sunny day! If there had been rain, less people would have come.

It was a very successful and this is the first time that such a big event of this kind has been held in France. This demonstration coincided with the anniversary of the law passed in 1973. Support for pro-life is increasing, especially since the Catholic hierarchy has granted it's support because of a bishop who now supports the pro-lifers.

Drugs and the FIFA 2010 World Cup

Everyone is talking about FIFA 2010: this, unfortunately, includes the drug syndicates. In a recent statement, the UN Office on Drugs and Crime stated that South Africa is in danger of becoming a major hub for drug trafficking. This is a definite understatement when looking at the amount of drugs that have been seized in the last 6 months at OR Tambo International airport, other major airports and harbours.

Further, the UN office's Jonathan Lucas said at the release of the International Narcotics Control Board's annual report, "West African syndicates had recently become major drug traffickers after Central American cartels began using them due to difficulty with their traditional routes." The problem with this is that if these new routes through West Africa were to be successfully dealt with by the authorities; Central American cartels would again look for other alternatives. Lucas asked, "When they are diverted, will they come to South Africa? Maybe?"

There is also the reality that the 2010 World Cup would worsen drug trafficking in our country. Law enforcement and customs officials will be under pressure due to massive tourist inflows during the tournament. Even SA's Central Drug Authority deputy chairperson David Bayever said, "We are aware it is going to be a big problem for us."

Another factor that must be mentioned is the Nigerian and Tanzanian syndicates in operation all over South Africa. They have very effective crime networks and make use of bribery to get their dirty business done. Drugs like heroin, cocaine, crack and ecstasy are rife not only in cities but also smaller towns and townships. An increasing problem is the low grade heroin based street drugs called by street names like Nyaope, Sugars, Pinch and half a dozen other names.

Together with all this an additional problem is the extension of school holidays during the World Cup. In addition to being at risk for substance abuse, children may also be lured into prostitution. A lot of evidence already shows that this is happening.

Like Bayever said "Our youth are going to be on holiday and they are going to be targeted to become prostitutes". Drugs, prostitution and human trafficking always go hand in hand wherever it is found.
